### Graveside honors for Pvt. David Bertram Frink, 1894-1973



Pvt. Frink's World War I military medals include the World War I Victory Medal with Army Battle Clasps awarded for the battles of St. Mihiel and Meuse-Argonne, along with the Defensive Sector Battle Clasp. On the right is the Army of Occupation of Germany Medal and service ribbon that were awarded to those who served in the European Occupation at the close of the war. Frink's grandson, Edward David Redwine, and daughter, Doris F. Redwine, have honored him with a donation to the Friends of Fort Caswell Rifle Range.
