Friends of Rifle Range gift books

Norma Eckard of the Friends of Fort Caswell Rifle Range recently presented a copy of the group's book to Erica Doshier, manager of the Barbee Library at Oak Island.

Donors dedicated to preserving Great War history gave 10 copies of "Brunswick County in the Great War" so that two copies will be available to the public at each of the five library branches in the county. Contributors toward the effort were Teresa McLamb, Kirk James, Judith Holden, Barbara Griffin and Gwen Causey.

The authors of the 580-plus-page book are Amy Eckard, webmaster/researcher, and Norma and Ronald Eckard, board members of the nonprofit.

The authors spent more than nine years gathering information about the 1918 Fort Caswell Rifle Range located in the Caswell Dunes residential community in Caswell Beach, and the men and women from Brunswick County who served in the Great War.
